
Greeting

Dear Friends / A Chairde,

I am very pleased to welcome you to **Wrocław** – the capital of Lower Silesia – in south-west Poland. Wroclaw Feis is the first international Irish dance competition in our region. I hope that, despite the winter season, you will have fun during the competition, and in your free time you will have the opportunity to visit our beloved city!

Please let me provide you with a little bit of information which you may find helpful getting here and moving around the city.

Wrocław is the third largest city in Poland. Situated in the south-west of Poland on the river Odra, close to the German and Czech borders, Wrocław is easily accessible for visitors from both western and southern Europe. Distance from other nearest capital cities:



Wrocław Copernicus Airport is located in the western outskirts of the city, only 5 kilometres away from the Wrocław Feis venue (10 minute drive or 35-40 minutes by public transport).

The feis venue is located in **Złotniki district**, part of Leśnica - a historical borough of Wrocław. There is very good communication to and from Leśnica to other parts of Wrocław, including the city centre. More details can be found in the Basic information section of the Syllabus.

Free parking is available in the vicinity of the feis venue.

As to the venue itself, it comprises a large hall with floor area 6 × 7,5 metres, two changing rooms as well as a warm-up area. There will also be a café serving refreshments open throughout the Feis.

Greeting

Due to health and safety reasons, limited number of spectators are allowed in the competiton area. Registration will start on 15.12.2022.

Apart from solo competitions on every level: beginner, primary and intermediate, Wroclaw Feis Championship will include Trophy Light and Trophy Hard competitions, as well as the Premier Championship. First place winners will receive a trophy, and at beginner level everyone will be read out and receive a medal.

In addition, we will hold the following group competitions: 2-hand and 4/6 hand, plus the special competition - Treble reel where each contestant will have the opportunity to perform in a creative outfit of their design. The theme for this competition is 'Gnomes'. Anyone who dresses up for the treble reel competition will receive a special prize.

Furthermore, we are planning to introduce a special contest 'My First Feis' for our youngest dancers (Under 10). Competing in 'My First Feis' is free of charge. Each contestant will receive a medal and a treat. More information can be found in the Additional Wroclaw Feis Rules section.

The following accompanying events will be held on the day of the Championship:

- Irish Culture Foundation will organise a workshop for the youngest dancers while waiting for the results. Taking part in the workshop will provide a great opportunity to take a break from the crowd and noise.
- Adult dancers and spectators are invited to a live Irish music session in Salonik Smaku (Braniborska 2/10), entrance from the furniture store "Domar") at 9 PM. Payments in cash only (PLN).

I hope that Wroclaw Feis will not only be a chance to take part in the organised competitions, but also a great opportunity to visit our beautiful city and look for the gnomes hiding in most unusual places.




Irish Spin

Basic information

Wroclaw Feis venue is located in Zlotniki district in the west of Wroclaw, close to the airport. You can get there by train, tram or bus.

For transportation, we recommend using app <u>Jakdojade</u> (it also has English version).





- Nearest train station: Wrocław Leśnica, 2 km (Kolejowa Street 20), Wrocław Żerniki 2,8 km, Wrocław Stadion 5 km
- Nearest tram stops: **Złotnicka**, 600 m (line 3, 10, 20)
- Nearest bus stops: Wielkopolska, 150 m (line 148)

Parking spaces for participants and spectators are available at the venue.

TROPHY, PRELIMINARY CHAMPIONSHIP & CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

- 1. Beginners Grade competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1st, 2nd or 3rd prize (please refer to the grid) in any competition for that particular dance.
- 2. In Beginners Grade competitions only basic steps may be performed.
- 3. Primary Grade competitions are confined to dancers who have never won 1st, 2nd or 3rd prize (please refer to the grid) for that particular dance other than in Beginners Grade.
- 4. Intermediate Grade competitions are open to all dancers who have not previously won 1st or 2nd prize (please refer to the grid) for that particular dance in Intermediate under the same or higher age limits. If a dancer in Continental Europe and Asia wins in Intermediate, they advance to the next level for the rest of the calendar year. Teachers can move dancers back at their own discretion at the start of the next calendar year.

5. For all Beginner, Primary and Intermediate competitions (excluding trophy competitions) the 32 bar method will be applied. Two and three hands are danced to 40 bars of music. Ceíli and figure dances are subject to the rules applied at Oireachtais. All Open dancers (see point 9c) will be required to dance to 48 bars of music in the reel and jig and 40 bars in the slip-jig and hornpipe.

- 6. Beginner, Primary and Intermediate Trophy Competitions, if included in the syllabus, will be a choice of A) light B) heavy dance. Dancers will dance 16 bars down the line in their chosen dance(s).
- 7. Traditional Set Dance competitions, dancers will have a choice out of 7 traditional dances: St. Patrick's Day, Blackbird, Job of Journeywork, Garden of Daisies, King of Fairies, Jockey to the Fair & Three sea Captains. If a dancer wins first place in any traditional set dance competition, that dancer moves on the next level in all 7 traditional set dances.
- 8. Traditional set dances may only be performed in the following competitions: Traditional Set dance competitions, Adult Championships and in the Under 8, Under and Under 10 Open Championships.
- 9. The Wroclaw Feis Premier Championship will be judged by 1 adjudicator.
 - a. Premier Championship U10: dancers are to perform the following: 1st round –
 Reel or Slip Jig, 2nd round Heavy Jig or Hornpipe, and 3rd round –
 Traditional Set.
 - b. If within this group there will be any Under 6 dancers, they will be required to dance 32 bars of the Reel for the 1st round and of the Light jig for the 2nd round. The top U6 dancer will be recognised and placed.
 - c. All Premier Championships will be judged as two solos and an overall Championship. Dancers will be required to dance 48 bars of music for the Reel & Heavy Jig, and 40 for Slip Jig & Hornpipe and a Modern Set. If there are more than 10 in the competition there may be a recall for the Modern Set round.
- 10. Where there are 5 or less dancers in any Championship placement will not affect grading.



OFFICIAL CLRG RULES

- 11. The lodgement of an entry will be taken to mean that teachers and pupils understand these rules and undertake to abide by them.
- 12. Objections must be lodged in writing within one hour of the announcement of the result of a competition accompanied by a fee of 40 Euro, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
- 13. The Adjudicators' decisions are final.
- 14. Only Feis officials may approach the adjudicators during competition sessions.
- 15. Age will be taken as on 1st January 2023 (whatever age you turn this year, in 2023, you dance under that age all year long, e.g., if a dancer's date of birth is 29 May 2013, she/he dances under 10 in the year 2023). Evidence of age may be requested, therefore dancers should have a valid ID with them in the event of a query as to their age.
- 16. Competitors must be in costume and ready to dance 30 minutes before their competitions are scheduled. Competitors must also be in full dancing costume and dancing shoes for award ceremonies.
- 17. The dress code in accordance with An Coimisiún rules will be strictly observed. For the sake of modesty and in the interest of safety to young people, dancers will not be permitted to walk around the Feis scantily dressed.
- 18. All Beginners and Primary dancers of all age groups may only wear a class costume, simple dancewear or appropriate attire (skirt and top/blouse, simple dress for girls and ladies, trousers and t-shirt/shirt for boys and gents. Make-up is not permitted for any dancer in the first two grades up to and including the Under 12 age group worldwide.
- 19. The Costume Rules of An Coimisiún, as amended, also apply in Continental Europe and Asia; it can be found in the "Rules" section on www.clrg.ie for reference. Female adult dancers participating in competitions entitled 'adult competition' and/ or 'adult grade competition' (both solo and team) are required to wear tights of a denier not less than 70.
- 20. Team dances (four hands and upward) must be performed as per the Coimisiún handbook "Ar Rinci Ceili".
- 21. By entering in competitions, dancers (or their legal representatives, in case of minors) consent to their names being stated in the feis results and in the public

Internet archives or any other feis entry/results system as may replace it.

- 22. Provided that dancers are not disturbed by flashlights or the like, photography and video recording by persons other than official feis photographers is allowed during Beginners and Primary competitions and during all award ceremonies. During Intermediate, Preliminary and Open competitions, ONLY the official feis photographer is permitted to take photos. Those who do not wish to be photographed should make themselves known to the Feis Organisers.
- 23. An Coimisiún has ruled that from 1st January each year, no block, en pointe, stationary or moving, be allowed to be performed for all ages up to and including the under 12 age group worldwide. The Under 12 Age Group will be allowed to toe walk from September 1st.
- 24. Within the limits specified in the Rules of An Coimisiún, the Organisers may at their discretion cancel or combine competitions with insufficient entries.
- 25. Order and quiet must be kept in the hall, particularly while competitors are dancing. Mobile phones must be switched to silent mode and any calls need to be taken outside the competition hall.
- 26. The Feis organizers cannot accept any liability for injury or loss or damage to property while on the premises.
- 27. No refunds will be made.

ADDITIONAL WROCLAW FEIS RULES


- 28. Smoking in the venue, as well as right next to the access doors and ventilation windows is strictly forbidden. The rule also applies to electronic cigarettes.
- 29. If you notice any defects or problems in the competition area, please inform the organisers about it.
- 30. Following the GDPR rules, any personal information the dancers or their guardians provided to the Wrocław Feis team will only be used to communicate information pertaining to their attendance at this year's feis. The Wrocław Feis team and Irish Spin School of Irish Dance will not use or forward this information to any third party.
- 31. In case of an emergency when there is a need for evacuating the building, please make your way towards the nearest emergency exit. Look out for staff


members in reflective vests who will point you in the right direction to ensure a smooth and safe evacuation process.

- 32. Due to health and safety reasons, limited number of spectators are allowed in the competiton area. Priority to enter the hall will be given to dancers and their quardians. Please follow any instructions from the ushers at the entrance to the sports hall and respect their decisions.
- 33. "My first Feis" competition is designed for youngest dancers not older than 10 y.o. who never competed in any Feis. During the competition dancers will be asked to dance simple threes, promenade steps or simple sevens for 16 bars of reel. This competition is free of charge. Please note that to register for this competition, you need to be present next to the stage after U13 soft shoes beginner competitions. For all participants medals and sweet treats have been prepared.
